- Riders to have reached 6 years of age by show date.
- Please ensure your entries are legible, complete and in by closing date. Incomplete or late entries may not be accepted or will incur a late fee.
- Ride times can be found at www.cowichanhorses.ca or the CDRC Facebook page by April 17th.
- Ribbons awarded to fifth place, except where noted differently.
- Tests will be available for pickup after each division is completed and until end of the show day.
- Show office will open at least one hour prior to first test of the day.
- Ride times are subject to change due to scratches, errors, or other unforeseen circumstances. Please check our Facebook page and website for the most up to date times.
- Please check in with the show office when you arrive to see if the schedule is running on time. Please be prepared to ride up to 15 minutes earlier than your posted time if required.
- Refunds will be given for any withdrawals up to the closing date. Any scratches after the closing date will only be refunded (minus admin fee) with presentation of vet or doctor's certificate.
- **STABLING:** Day stall \$30. Overnight \$50(includes day fee). **Bedding, forks and wheelbarrows are available.** Please indicate stabling on your entry form. If horses are staying overnight in the stalls and declared a responsible adult (18yrs or older) **must** stay with the horses overnight on site. The exhibition grounds lock the gate in the evening for safety. There is a phone number for emergencies. Gate opens Saturday evening 5:30 unless with prior arrangement. Gate opens at 7:30am Sunday morning.
- **Volunteering:** Volunteer sign-up sheet found on-line on www.cowichanhorses.ca and must be completed to be considered for show entry.
